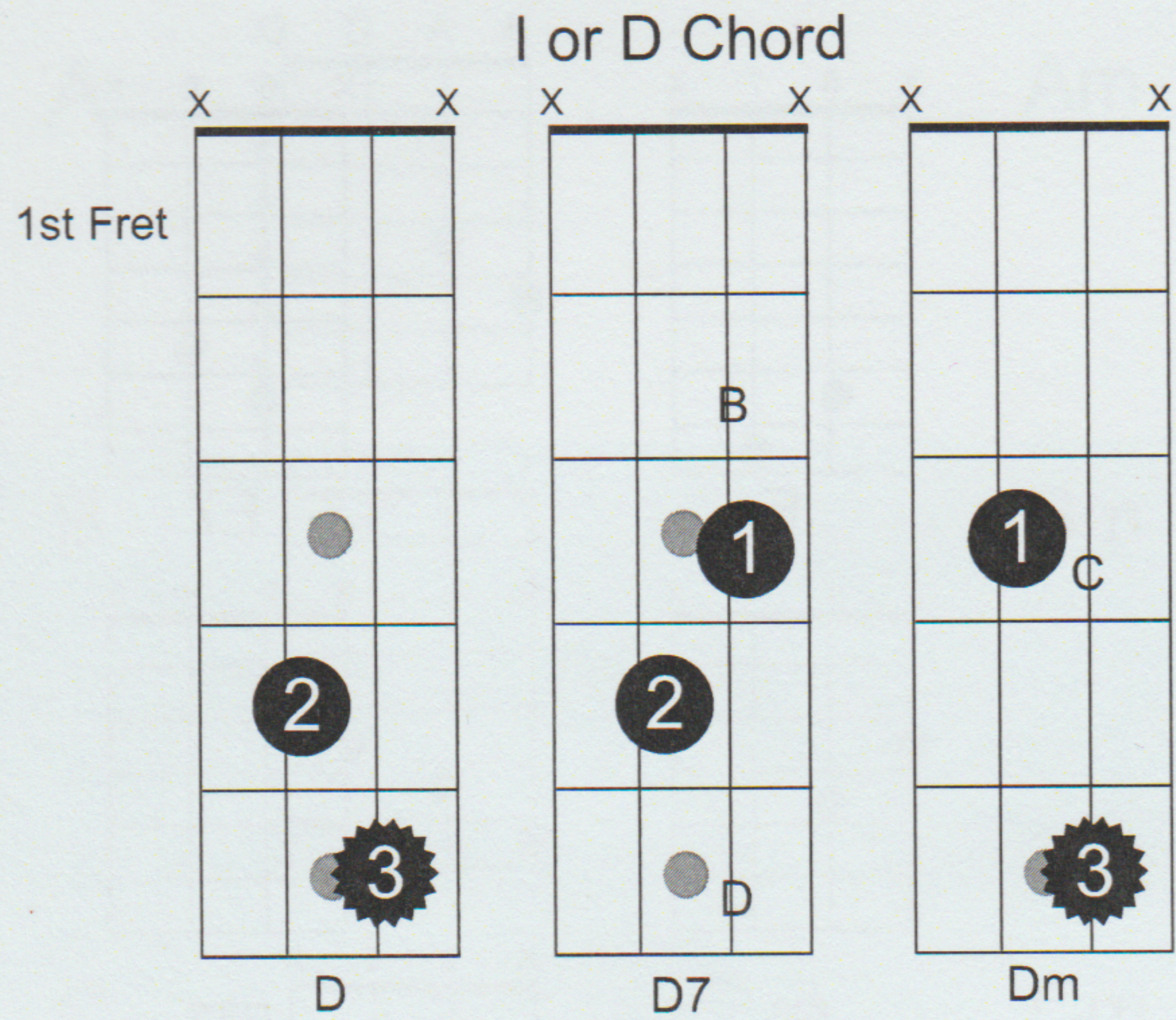


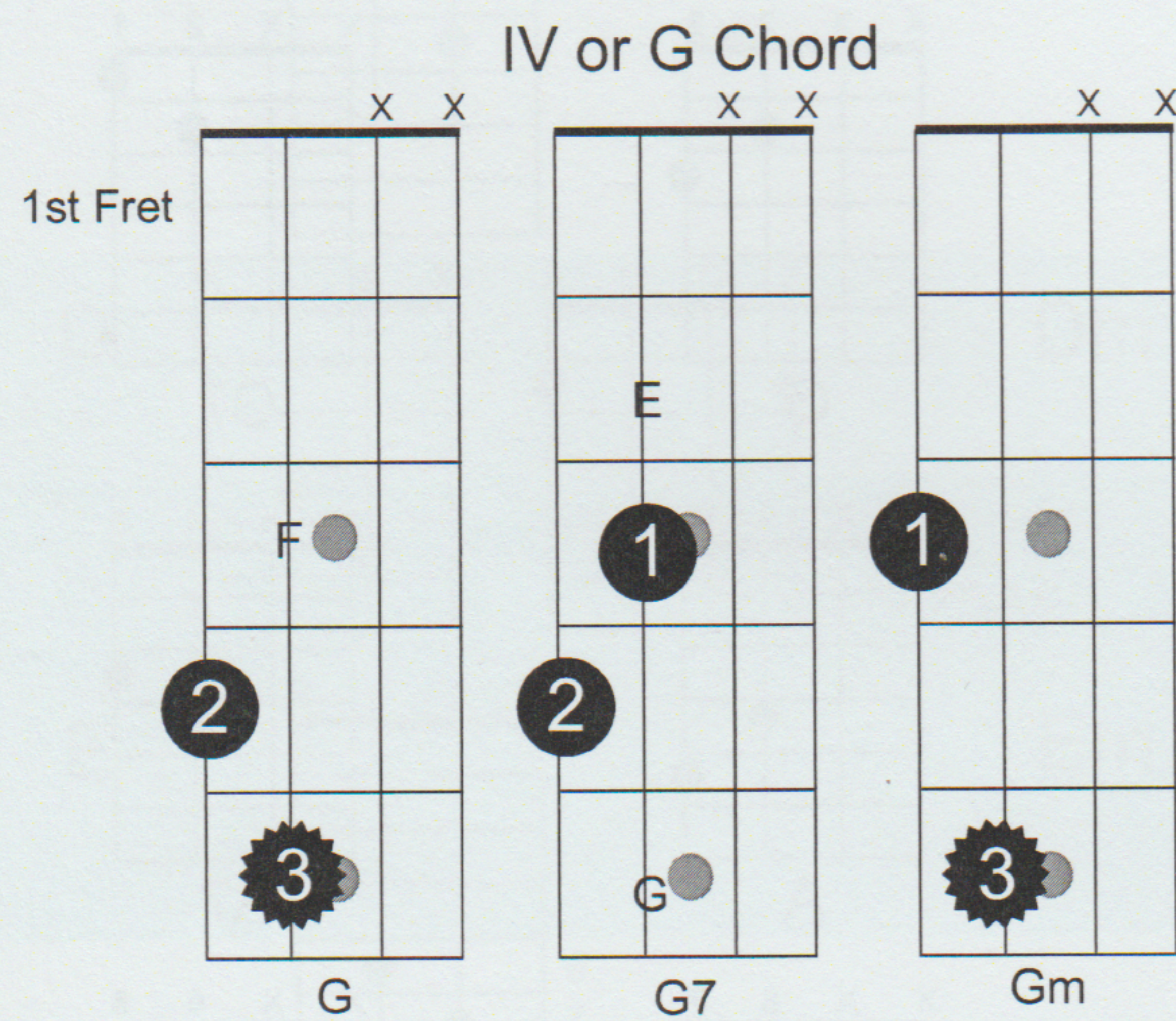
Simple 2 Finger Mandolin Chords for a I, IV, V Progression



Using two fingers you can produce the three basic positions for each chord; major, 7th and the minor.

The I or the D chord uses the 2nd and 3rd strings.

The IV or G chord uses the 1st and 2nd strings.



The V or A chord uses the 3rd and 4th strings.

The star is your root note or the name of the chord. Using these basic shapes you can move up and down and across the fret board to produce your chords.

These positions can be repeated in many places.
